State Property Information Search System (VTIPS)	The VTIPS data, data provided by property managers, including personal data, are stored in the database for 5 years. After the expiry of this term, the data are transferred to the archive and stored for 5 years. Upon expiry of the period of data storage in the archives, the data are destroyed, except for those which, in the cases prescribed by law, must be transferred to the state archives. The data from property managers on unregistered property stored in the VTIPS database are destroyed when they are entered into a relevant register. Upon expiry of this period, the data are transferred to the archive, where they are stored for 10 years, and upon expiry of this period, they are destroyed in accordance with the procedure laid down by the Chief Archivist of Lithuania. Register of persons who have restricted their ability to gamble	<p>Once the Register's data are changed in the Register's database, the old entries are transferred to the Register's database archive no later than the next working day and stored therein until the Register's object is deregistered from the Register and its data are destroyed.</p> <p>The Register's object is deregistered:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. automatically, when the period of validity of the request to prevent gambling expires, at 24:00 on the last day of the period; 2. when the data provider of the Register withdraws the request to prevent gambling, the object of the Register is deemed to be deregistered from 24:00 on the next calendar day, when the data on the date and time of the withdrawal of the request are entered in the Register; 3. automatically upon receipt of the data of the Population Register of the Republic of Lithuania on the death of the Register's object. <p>Upon deregistration of the Register's object, the data of the Register's object are automatically transferred to the archive of the Register without delay and stored in it for an indefinite period, except for personal data.
